- **1. Question:** Are we to provide knobs or levers on the new doors for the bathrooms (privacy sets)? Did not see a hardware schedule for those doors.
- **1. Answer:** See specification 08 71 00, contractor shall provide 8K Knob Series.
- **2. Question:** Does this project involve any Asbestos and/or Lead Containing Materials that are to removed as part of this project?
- 2. Answer: Building has been assessed for presence of lead and asbestos, and none were detected.
- **3. Question:** The specifications and plans are calling for a 3"x3" mosaic tile in the showers, but that particular size is not available in the style/color that is selected. That style has a 1"x3" mosaic -- should we go with that, or find an alternate 3" square tile for the showers?
- **3. Answer:** Contractor shall provide a 3"x3" tile as specified, see note Sheet A-401 Color and Material Selections.
