Contractor shall remove the window for the Telecommunications Room (115). Existing window unit shall be removed completely including but not limited to sashes, perimeter frames, screening, sill panning, perimeter anchors, etc. Existing precast concrete window sill is to remain. Provide new window infill construction consisting of 3-5/8" steel studs at 16" O.C. with 1/2" glass mat gypsum board sheathing at the exterior side, covered with 15# felt underlayment; provide polyurethane spray foam insulation application full depth of the stud cavity, and horizontal 7/8" furring channels at the interior side to match the depth of the wall type "A" construction illustrated on sheet G-002, and 5/8" gypsum board at the interior side. Provide brick masonry at the exterior with strap ties at 16" O.C. each way, to match existing brick masonry in color, texture, and plane of installation. Leave existing jamb brick at window opening intact, do not tooth new masonry into existing but rather install as a knock-out panel should a window ever be reinstalled in the opening.

Door 115A for the Telecommunications Room (115) shall swing outward.

Provide/Install 2 CAT5E cables from the DDC modem to the Telecommunications Room (115) within 1" conduit.

Contractor shall remove all furnishings from the building to facilitate work per the contract. Provide three 10' x 20' connex boxes for the storage of materials from inside BLDG 421. Contractor shall photograph, tag, record the location of, remove from the building, and store each piece of furniture. Contractor shall provide an electronic copy of the furniture condition pictures and furniture locations to the government on CD. Furniture is typical of an office environment. Contractor shall protect each item removed from damage. Contractor shall place all items removed back in the building.
